Community Empowerment & Accountability



Accountable Communities of Health (ACHs) will:

- **Provide a multi-sector voice** for delivery system reform, shared health improvement goals and regional purchasing strategies.
- **Serve as a forum for regional collaborative decision-making** to accelerate health system transformation, focusing on social determinants of health, clinical-community linkages, and whole person care.
- **Accelerate physical and behavioral health care integration** through financing and delivery system adjustments, starting with Medicaid.

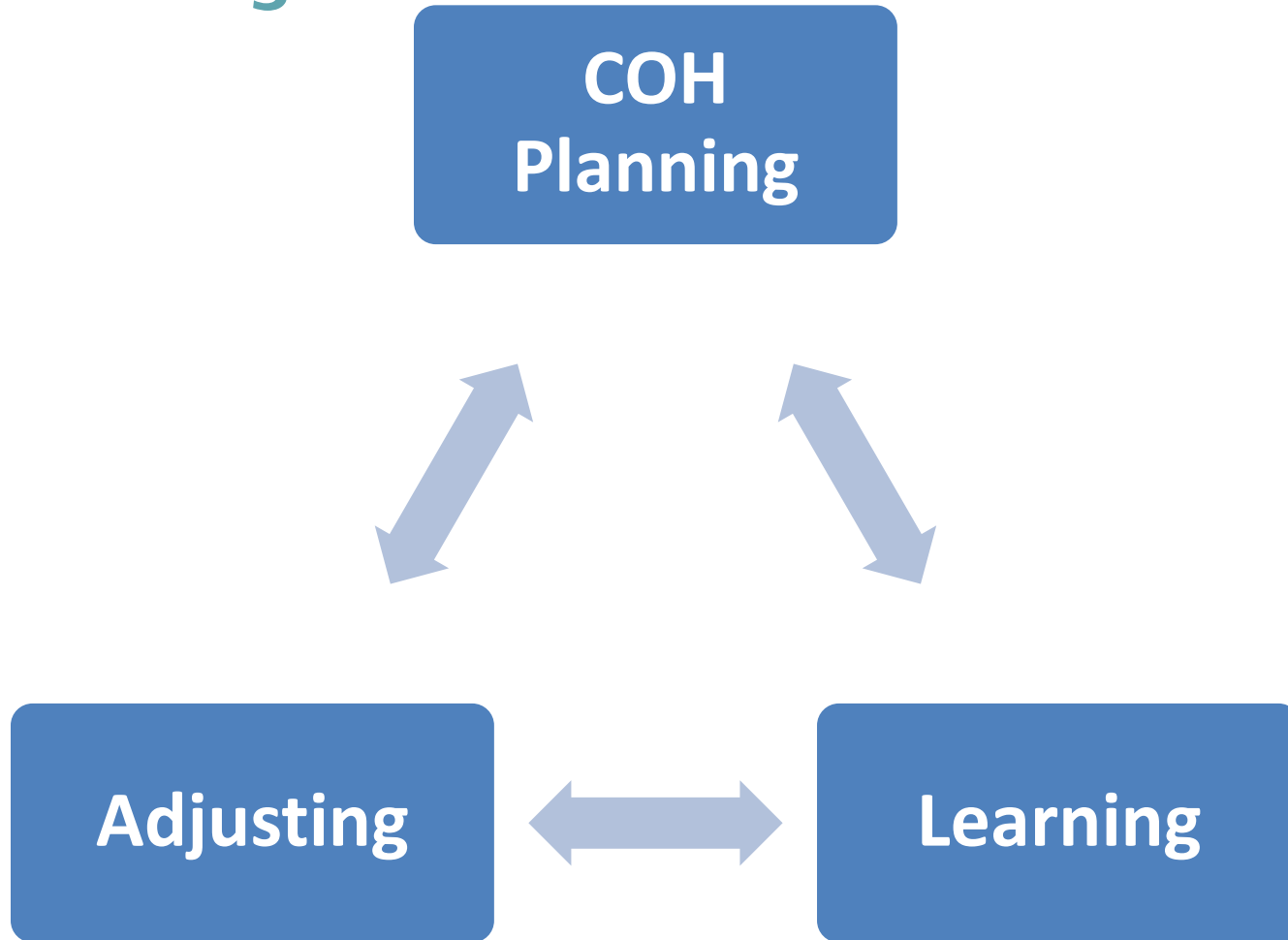


SIM Round 2 Grant Application

A roadmap for the work ahead. The plan will articulate consideration of, progress toward or implementation of:

- **Common agenda and opportunities for alignment**
- **Milestones and outcomes**
- **Shared measurement strategy**
- **Potential ACH transformation role**
- **Plan of action**
- **Lead organization**
- **Communication framework**
- **Governance structure**
- **RSA alignment**

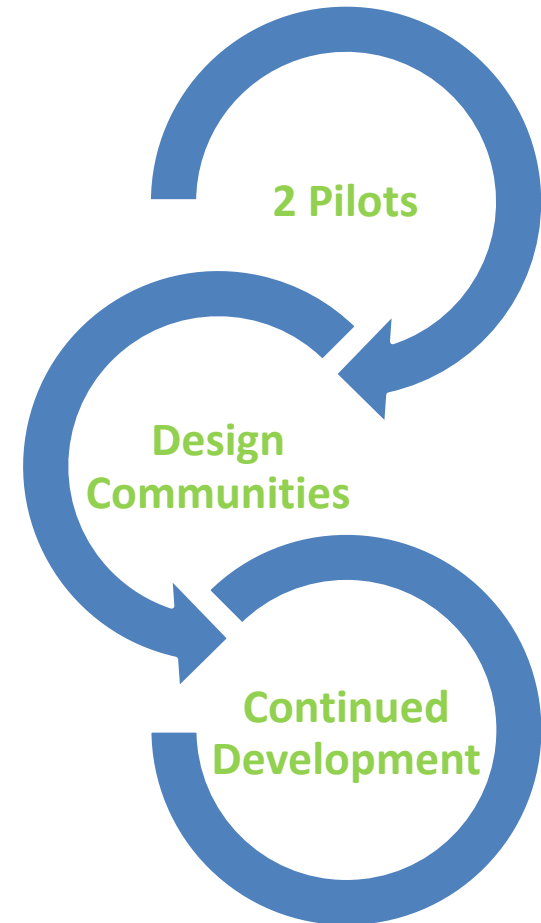


Community of Health Principles

- **Focus on the Triple Aim**, recognizing the overall goal of the Innovation Plan is improved care, improved health, and lower costs
- **Redefining "partnership"**, by leveraging the strengths and resources of local communities and the state to meet the needs of both.
- **We will meet you where you are**, and it's important for communities to balance ambition with an honest self-assessment

A Look Ahead to 2015...

- We know that two Pilot ACHs will be funded through E2SHB 2572
- We are confident that continued statewide support will be available going forward
- Our goal is to provide the right resources at the right time for the right reason





Design Communities

Design Communities will:

- **Leverage the Community of Health (COH) planning process, including the newly developed Community Health Plans**
- **Respond to lessons learned during the COH planning process**
- **Focus on capacity building, building on lessons learned from the Pilots**



Pilot ACHs

Pilot ACHs will:

- Complete a “startup initiative” to demonstrate the valuable role of ACHs
- Test and inform ACH designation criteria, to be finalized by the end of 2015
- Provide learning opportunities as a peer leader to Design communities
- Inform the statewide ACH evaluation design, including rapid-cycle learning and improvement

Considerations and Emphasis

1. Governance and Organizational Structure

The emphasis is on the existing or planned:

- Decision making process
- Organizational structure for the region, to leverage the multi-sector representation



Considerations and Emphasis

2. Engagement and Representation

- **The level of multi-sector representation**
- **Existing or planned engagement efforts to include the appropriate stakeholders and partners**
- **Existing or planned agreements, communication plans, etc.**



Considerations and Emphasis

3. Sustainability and Buy-in

- The degree to which current efforts would move forward without additional State funding
- The level of existing buy-in and momentum within the community
- The level of philanthropic support and participation
